# 30,000 foot view of Legislature in 2018

---

- Last year of Governor Brown's 4<sup>th</sup> term!
- California "Holding the Line" against Washington DC efforts to undermine environmental and health protections (Clean Air Act; TSCA reform etc.)
- Affordable Housing, Cap and Trade, Net Neutrality, Bail Bond and others took center stage
- Governor Brown's "Climate Summit" in San Francisco in mid September highlighted California's global leadership in climate policy

# 2018/2019 one of busiest legislative sessions for CCDEH/CAEHA

---

## WHY?

- 2018 second year of 2017/2018 two-year session
- Shared Economy spurs change in regulation
- “Progressive” agenda with super majority of Democrats in both houses and All Constitutional Officers
- Demographic shifts

# CCDEH & CAEHA Legislative Process

---

- **CCDEH:** 62 official EH Directors plus Associates
- **CAEHA:** Business and Lobbying arm of CCDEH: 501c3 non-profit
- All legislative positions established by one of 8 CCDEH policy committees, ratified by Executive Committee
- CAEHA requested to lobby CCDEH positions on legislation and regulatory matters

# Priority Bills in 2018

---

- **FOUR CAEHA-SPONSORED BILLS**
- **INITIAL LIST OF 224 BILLS IN MARCH 2018 REVIEWED BY CCDEH POLICY COMMITTEES**
- **PRIORITY LIST OF 35 BILLS ESTABLISHED BY MAY 2018**
- **CCDEH/CAEHA TRACKED 102 BILLS THROUGH END OF SESSION**
- **CAEHA-REQUESTED AMENDMENTS TAKEN TO 8 BILLS ENABLED LOCAL EH TO GO NEUTRAL OR SUPPORT**
