## NOTES ON KEY BILLS AS OF SEPTEMBER 17, 2018:

- **All four CAEHA sponsored bills (AB 2178; AB 2524; AB 2902 & AB 3178) On Governor's desk.**
- **AB 626 (Garcia) Microenterprise home kitchens:** Passed out of Senate Health 7-0. **On Governor's desk.** CCDEH/CAEHA position changed back to O/A. Mtg with Governor Office with CHEAC 8/22/2018.
- **SB 946 (Lara) Sidewalk vending:** CAEHA requested amendments retaining CalCode authority taken. **On Governor's desk.**
- **AB 1884 (Calderon) Straws:** CAEHA requested amendments to allow NOV were taken. **On Governor's desk.**
- **SB 1192 (Monning) Children's meals:** Amendments that CAEHA requested taken to allow NOV before issuing penalties/fines were taken. **Bill held in Assembly Rules**
- **AB 2660 (Quirk) CFB moved to Oppose. Bill held in Senate EQ**
- **SB 966 (Wiener) Onsite water reuse:** Working on amendments but SWRCB and Legislature resisting because of cost. **On Governor's desk.**
