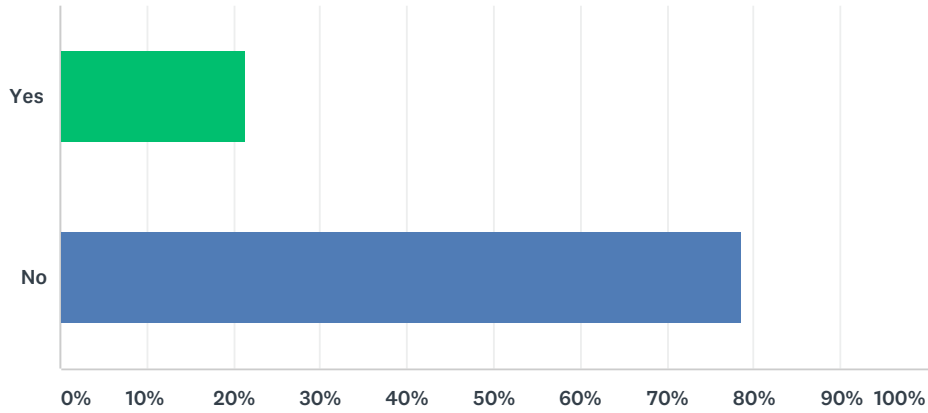


Q1 Does your local Environmental Health Department (EHD) CURRENTLY have a routine cannabis health/safety inspection program for retailers/dispensaries?

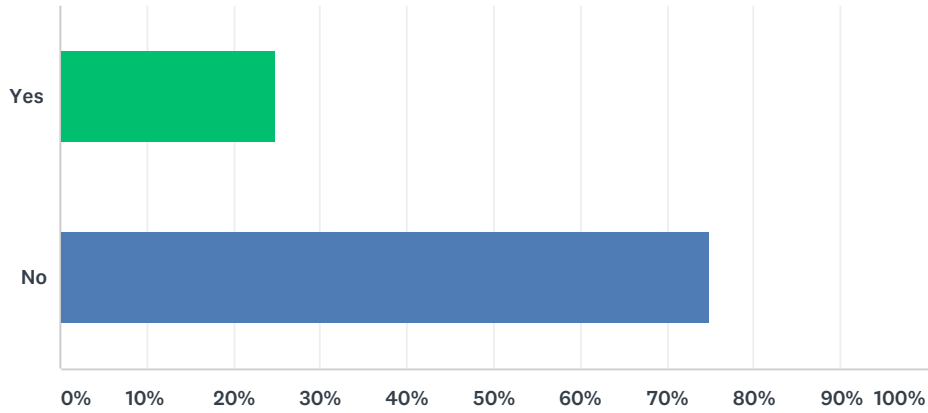

Q2 Does your local Environmental Health Department (EHD) CURRENTLY have a routine cannabis health/safety inspection program for manufacturing?

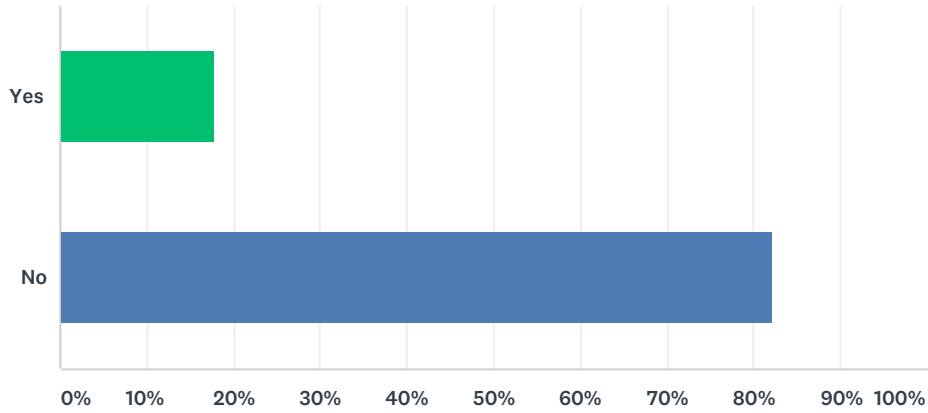

Q3 Does your local Environmental Health Department (EHD) CURRENTLY have a routine cannabis health/safety inspection program for cultivation?

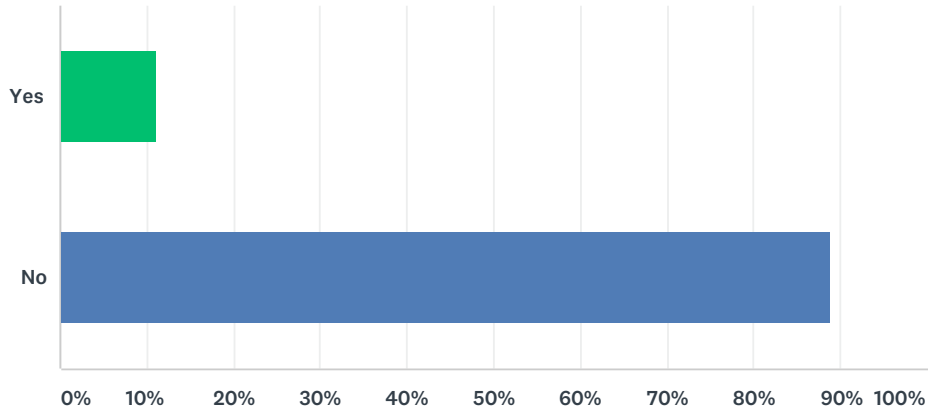

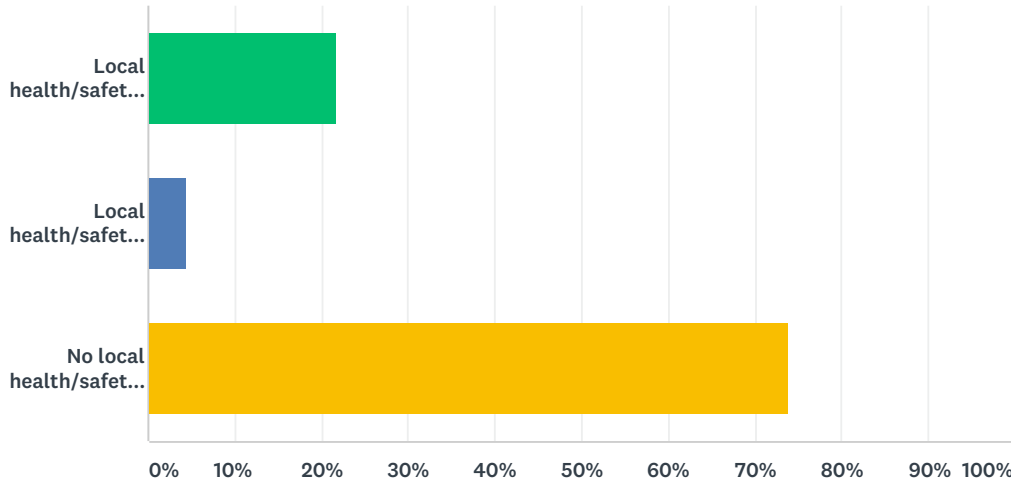

11	Local code prohibits commercial or industrial cannabis activity including but not limited to manufacture, distribution, processing, storing, packaging, labeling, laboratory testing, transportation, deliveries, and sales are prohibited in all zoning districts. Growing and processing for personal use is restricted to 6 plants per residence for non-medicinal use or 12 plants per residence for medicinal use.
